He's a lifetime member of the American Motorcycle Association and the White Rose Motorcycle Club.

Cy enjoyed the “farm” early on where he hunted and bagged several bucks and later enjoyed time with Donna there. Cy, Donna, and friends would spend time clearing the trails of fallen trees. He also had a passion for corn on the cob and planted several acres at the “farm” and would harvest it and would take it to family and friends, who looked forward to the tasty sweetcorn. Cy also enjoyed his dogs, Buddy 1 and Buddy 2.
