



## Jeffrey P. Weaver

May 10, 1945 - May 21, 2024

“He loved God, he loved his family, he loved his church, and he loved to sing.” Jeffrey Paul Weaver of Mechanicsburg passed away on Tuesday, May 21, 2024. Jeff was born to Beatrice (Keller) and J. Fred Weaver on May 10, 1945, in Harrisburg Hospital. The family moved to Needham, MA in 1952 where Jeff graduated from Needham High School in 1963. He then graduated from Lafayette College in 1967 with a degree in Civil Engineering and was a member of the Kappa Delta Rho Fraternity. Jeff started working for PennDOT following graduation where he spent his entire career working as a Civil Engineer, retiring in 2005 as the District 8 Assistant District Engineer for Design. Jeff met his loving wife, Bert, in 1966, and they were later married on April 20, 1968.

Jeff is survived by his wife, Bert, his three children, Amy Czyzyk (George DeMartyn), Jim Weaver (Becky), and Dave Weaver (Nikki), his six grandchildren (Corey, Sam, Loudon, Ellie, Lily, and Lexy), and his three siblings (Barbara Cone, Jane Lawrence, and Michael Weaver). Some of his favorite activities were singing in the choir, being the webmaster for 15 years, and playing guitar and singing with the Sunday School children.
