John G. Clements, 91, of Camp Hill died February 25, 2020 at Homeland Center following a brief illness. He was born on November 24, 1928 to Roy A. Clements and Helen Achenbach Clements. He is survived by his wife of 64 years, Beverly Thomas Clements, his three children Kimberly J. Clements of Mechanicsburg, Susanne C. Ehgartner (Greg) of Enola, Jeffrey G. Following his retirement from the West Shore School District he became the owner of Johnson Imaging Systems in Camp Hill. As a member of the Boy Scouts of America, he earned the rank of Eagle Scout. He was a member of Coral Gables Lodge No. 260, Coral Gables FL, Tall Cedars of Lebanon, the Harrisburg Consistory, and Trinity Lutheran Church where over the years he served on the church council, world missions, property and building committees. He was a past member of the West Shore Kiwanis Club. A memorial service will be held on Saturday, March 7 at 11:00 am at Trinity Lutheran Church 2000 Chestnut Street in Camp Hill, with visitation beginning at 10:00 am.
