Kenneth M. Bistline, age 90, of Mechanicsburg passed away on Sunday, April 8 at his home.

He was born on October 15, 1927, son of the late Joseph and Clara (Wagoner) Bistline.

Mr. Bistline was an Army veteran and a retired Executive Vice President of Dauphin Deposit Bank and Trust Company. He was an active member of Trinity Lutheran Church in Camp Hill.
