Lewis F. Kramer, 91, of Camp Hill, PA, and formerly of The Essex House, Lemoyne, PA, passed away peacefully on June 7, 2024 at Claremont Nursing Home. Lewis graduated from Camp Hill High School, and served in the United States Marine Corps during the Korean War. He was the Manager of New Center West, and was later employed by Specialty Bakery. He was very active along with his spouse in American Legion Post 1001, N. Harrisburg, where he served as a Commander. He was a longtime member of Camp Hill Church of God.

Lew was a devoted husband, father, grandfather, great-grandfather, brother and friend. He was actively involved in coordinating reunions with his former Marine Corps brothers he served alongside. He actively served in the Honor Guard participating in ceremonial events and funerals whenever called upon.
