Linda Marie O'Donnell Tocket, 71, of Mechanicsburg, Pennsylvania passed away on April 20, 2025, at home surrounded by her immediate family. She had retired from the Department of Environmental Protection after 17 years in 2019. Before that, she spent 12 years at Phico Insurance Company and 7 years working for the federal government. Born on October 20th, 1953, Linda was the daughter of Elizabeth and Dr. John O'Donnell. Linda was preceded in death by her parents Dr. John and Elizabeth O'Donnell of Lemoyne, her sister, Pam Intreri, and brother, John Edward O'Donnell II.

Linda is survived by her sister, Marsha Leitzel of Mechanicsburg, her husband of 43 years, Donald Tocket of Mechanicsburg, and two daughters; Kelly Tocket of Nashville, Tennessee and Kristi Tocket of Christchurch, New Zealand. Linda spent her retirement years by the pool, enjoying the sunshine and keeping busy by staying in touch with and visiting loved ones. Her warmth and kindness for people and animals will be greatly missed.
