Lori Lynn Fultz, age 57, passed away on April 2, 2020 at Penn State Hershey Medical Center after a courageous four-year battle with cancer.

Lori was born on October 27, 1962 in Harrisburg, Pennsylvania to Donald Friese and Dorothy (Radabaugh) Friese. Lori married Scott Fultz in June of 1989 and recently celebrated 30 years of a marriage that was filled with immense joy and love for one another. She worked at the Pennsylvania State Capitol as a legislative secretary for Representative Kerry Benninghoff of Centre County and was known for her kindness and warm spirit. She found purpose assisting in the organization of the Cancer Caucus, which helps advocate for awareness and research for new and better cancer treatments.

Lori spent her life surrounded by love and was a fiercely loyal wife, mother, sister, and friend. She is survived by her husband, Scott, two siblings, Steven Friese and Dawn Knisely, as well as two children, McClain and Mia, and her beloved dog, Daisy. Lori had a love for people and an ability to talk to anyone. She will be remembered for her intentionality and presence that was palpable to anyone who knew her. Lori enjoyed spending time at the beach, and was especially happy to be there with those who loved her most.
