Marlin K. Ulsh, 101, of Mechanicsburg passed away peacefully on Friday, September 12, 2025 at Country Meadows. Born on June 9, 1924, son of Verna and Chester Ulsh of Millerstown. He was preceded in death by his wife, Clara, and sisters, Janet Numer and Arlene Broberg.

Marlin was a World War II Army veteran. Following the army, he enrolled in Central Pennsylvania Business College and continued his finance education at Wharton School of Accounts and Finance. He held various positions at United Telephone System, last as Vice-President, Finance. Before retiring in 1988, he was the Vice-President of Gannett Fleming Valuation and Rate Consultants.

Beyond his professional roles, he was devoted to his churches, Fifth Street United Methodist and Trinity Church of New Cumberland, by serving on the Board of Trustees, Finance Commission, Stewardship Committee, and Administrative council. He also did volunteer work at Holy Spirit Hospital and American Red Cross.
