Michael “ Mike” Crognale, 89, of West Fairview, passed away Tuesday February 11, 2025 at Country Meadows Retirement Center. Born August 20, 1935, in West Fairview, Pennsylvania, Mike was one of five boys born to the late Donato & Domenica Crognale (Ciccocioppo). He is survived by two brothers: Victor Crognale of Camp Hill and Joseph Crognale, of West Fairview, as well as many nieces and nephews. Mike was preceded in death by brothers Thomas and John Crognale, nieces Lisa and Mary Beth Crognale and his nephew Ethan Crognale.
