Nina Fedorovich, 101, passed peacefully on January 9, 2024 at her home in Camp Hill, Pennsylvania. She was born on April 14, 1922 to Feodor Fedorovich and Alexandra Charnetsky in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania. Nina has always been proud of her Russian-Ukrainian heritage, helping other immigrants from Russia and Ukraine settle in the Harrisburg area. She graduated from high school in 1940 and went on to pursue higher education at HACC and Dickinson College, retiring from the Social Security Administration and from the Pennsylvania State government. She also enjoyed listening to classical music and always had season tickets to the Harrisburg Symphony Orchestra, playing piano, singing in the choir at Pine Street Presbyterian Church, ice skating in the Hershey Figure Skating club, skiing with the Susquehanna Ski Club well into her 80s, and swimming laps at Central Penn Fitness well into her 90s. Nina was also a cat lover, supporting animal welfare organizations throughout her life.
