



## Pearl Heiges Kent

Pearl Heiges Kent, formerly of Highland Park, died on Tuesday, May 19, 2015 at Holy Spirit Hospital. Pearl was born on October 10, 1913 in Lemoyne and was proud to say she was 101 and half years old. She is the daughter of the late Irvin and Bessie (Groff) Heiges and the widow of Clifton T. Kent.
