Peter Dellane, 84, of Chambersburg, PA, passed away on September 9, 2021.

He was born in Newark, NJ, on July 4, 1937, to the late Peter and Mary (Swaczy) Dellane. Peter graduated from Hillside High School 1955. He retired from being a co-proprietor of the Forest Lake Inn, Friendsville, PA.
