Peter S. Pennington, 80, of Camp Hill, passed away peacefully at home on Wednesday, March 6, 2019. Peter will be lovingly remembered by his wife of 16 years, Susan, two daughters, Whitney Leber (Michael) and Stephanie Di Tullio (Carlo), a brother Phelps Pennington (Ann), a stepsister Jane Sulzberger, a stepbrother Robert Bigham (Beverley), a stepson Kevin Sellers (Kimberly), five granddaughters Amelia and Elizabeth Leber, Sophia Di Tullio, Kourtney and Katelyn Sellers, and many more family.
