January 4, 1930 - February 26, 2024

Shirley E. Snell, 94, passed away peacefully on February 26, 2024, at Luther Acres, Lititz, Pennsylvania, where she resided since May 2017. Shirley suffered a severe stroke in July 2012 which caused her to move to assisted living at Ecumenical Retirement Community in Paxtang prior to being admitted to skilled care in Lititz.

Shirley was born in Barberton, Ohio on January 4, 1930, and graduated from East High School in Akron, Ohio. She was predeceased by her husband of 58 years, William R. Snell, her mother, Hazel L.
