Suzanne Boyd Lynch, age 55, passed away suddenly in her sleep on August 30, 2020. She was a beloved wife, sister, niece, aunt, cousin, co-worker, and friend. Suzanne was born in Harrisburg on January 5, 1965 to William J. Boyd, MD and Jeanne Z. Boyd. Preceding Sue in death were her parents, and her maternal aunts and uncle.

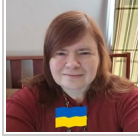
