Warren B. Stumpf, of 1133 country club road, Camp Hill, Pennsylvania, departed this life on May 7, 2015.

A graduate of Butler, New Jersey High School, he was a United States Marine, Veteran of the Korean War, and World War II.

Warren worked in the Insurance Industry, fifty five years. He retired as Branch Manager of Princeton Insurance Company. He was a longtime member of Harrisburg, Y.M.C.A., past president of Morristown, New Jersey, Optimist Club, member of American Legion, and member of Trinity Lutheran Church, in Camp Hill, Pennsylvania.
