William L. Mangold, PhD, was born March 30, 1948 in Benton Harbor, Michigan, the first of three sons born to Gordon L. and Marjorie (Klute) Mangold. Bill graduated from Three Oaks, Michigan High School and earned bachelor's and master's degrees at Western Michigan University, Kalamazoo. After marrying the former Kathleen A. Eynon, he relocated to Pennsylvania, living in Highspire and later in New Cumberland. Bill worked at Penn State-Harrisburg and earned an MA degree there. He also taught anthropology at Harrisburg Area Community College and Penn State-York. After moving to Indiana in 1991 to accept a position as deputy state archaeologist for the Indiana Department of Natural Resources, Bill earned a PhD at Indiana University in Bloomington. He retired to South Bend in 2011 and practiced contract archaeology and assisted at Notre Dame Field schools.

Bill was a member of Christ the King Lutheran Church, South Bend, where a funeral was held on Friday, November 15.

Bill is survived by his beloved wife, Kathleen (Eynon) Mangold; his brother,

Donald J. (Brenda) Mangold of Niles, Michigan; his brothers-in-law Nick (Mary) Foster of Harrisburg and Pete (Carolyn) Haines of Lancaster; 10 nieces and nephews; 16 grand-nieces and grand-nephews; and one great-grand-niece.

A graveside service with burial following will be held at the Highspire Cemetery on Wednesday, November 20 at 12:00 noon. All friends and family are welcome to attend.
